WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

The colour is a brilliant transparent light straw with hints of lime green.

The bouquet is benchmark varietal Leeuwin Estate Sauvignon Blanc; aromas of crushed gooseberry, green bean, cut grass and lifted white currant intermingling with passionfruit and lime citrus, which is very lifted and intense.

The rampant fruit flavours appear again on the palate with an intensity of lime citrus, green bean and the white currant flavours of a very fine Sauvignon Blanc. The palate is long and balanced indicating both style and definition.

The layers of flavour have the clarity and freshness from a standout vintage year for the southern part of the Margaret River region.
