WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Colour is ruby plum with some brilliant purple edges. The nose shows fragrant lifted French oak with delicate but rich plum and blackberry fruits and the classical white pepper and spice evident in a great year. The superb fruit ripeness of the vintage conditions carries the same intense rich plum and sweet blackberry flavours onto the palate. A wonderfully structured wine with lingering sweet fruit which helps provide good length accompanied by fine grain tannins.

COMMENTS

Bright red-purple; an elegant, medium-bodied array of cherry, plum and blackberry fruits; fine tannins and supporting oak. Screwcap. 13.5% alc. Rating 93. Drink 2015
