

# MOORE'S CREEK CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2004

The Moore's Creek range of wines takes its name from the spring fed creek that runs from the Brokenback Range through our HVD (Hunter Valley Distillery) and Penfoldvale vineyards. These wines are designed as immediate drinking varietals, suitable for a multitude of occasions and food styles.



## TASTING NOTES

Black cherries and wild berries with spicy clove characters dominate the nose, with intense, varietal characters on the palate. The result is a flavour ripe wine with a hint of oak and subtle structured tannin on the finish.

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine is a blend of Cabernet fruit sourced from the Riverland SA (87%), Mudgee (12%) and McLaren Vale SA (1%). The fruit was transformed into this wine using modern fermentation techniques. After fermentation the wine matured in a combination of American and French oak, to soften the palate and enhance the flavour complexity prior to final blending and bottling. Alc.14 %

## SERVING SUGGESTIONS

The aromas and colour hint at the intensity of this wine. A full-bodied red, that will make it an ideal accompaniment to red meats and aged cheeses.
