The Moore's Creek range of wines takes its name from the spring fed creek that runs from the Brokenback Range through our HVD (Hunter Valley Distillery) and Penfoldvale vineyards in the Hunter Valley of NSW, Australia.

These Moore's Creek wines are designed in a drink now style of wine and are suitable accompaniments to a multitude of occasions and food styles.



TASTING NOTES

The 2004 Moore's Creek Shiraz is medium purple and red in colour. The nose displays aromas of ripe plum fruits and chocolate and vanilla essence. Sweet Shiraz fruits and spicy peppery characters are evident on the palate, which is supported by the integration of tannins.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Fermented in open vats and hand plunged to extract flavour and colour this Shiraz then matured in a combination of French and American oak barriques. A percentage of the wine also received oak maturation in large oak casks for a period of eight to twelve months.
